Internet Governance Forum (IGF)

- IGF is an UN activity initiated in 2006 as a global forum for multi-stakeholder policy dialogue on prevailing and merging issues on internet governance so as to foster the sustainability, robustness, security, stability and development of Internet. Further information on its mandate can be found in <http://www.intgovforum.org/cms/index.php/aboutigf>
- Assisting the UN Secretary General in convening the Internet Governance Forums is the MAG (Multistakeholder Advisory Group) comprised of 50 Members drawn globally from governments, the private sector and civil society, including representatives from the academic and technical communities.
- The annual Forum was held in Greece (2006), Brazil (2007), India (2008), and Egypt (2009), and in 2010 is to be held in September 14-17 in Vilnius, Lithuania.
