# IANA Operations

- Ideally should be able to communicate with a TLD registry
- IANA Whois reference requires
  - Up to date contact information
    - Changes to Sponsor orgs need supporting documentation
  - Non-recursive NS
- Send requests to [root-mgmt@iana.org](mailto:root-mgmt@iana.org)
- Automation work progressing to support future TLD growth and work load

# ccTLD security and resiliency capacity building initiative



- Partnered with ccTLD regional organizations to provide training/exercise events to develop capacity
  - Managerial-level Attack and Crises Response Planning course – process & best practice
  - Technical-level hands-on defense techniques in simulated threat environment
  - Workshop to establish exercise programs
- Offered to run an Internet Registry Operations Course at APRICOT 2010 – cancelled 1 week before start (lack of interest??)
