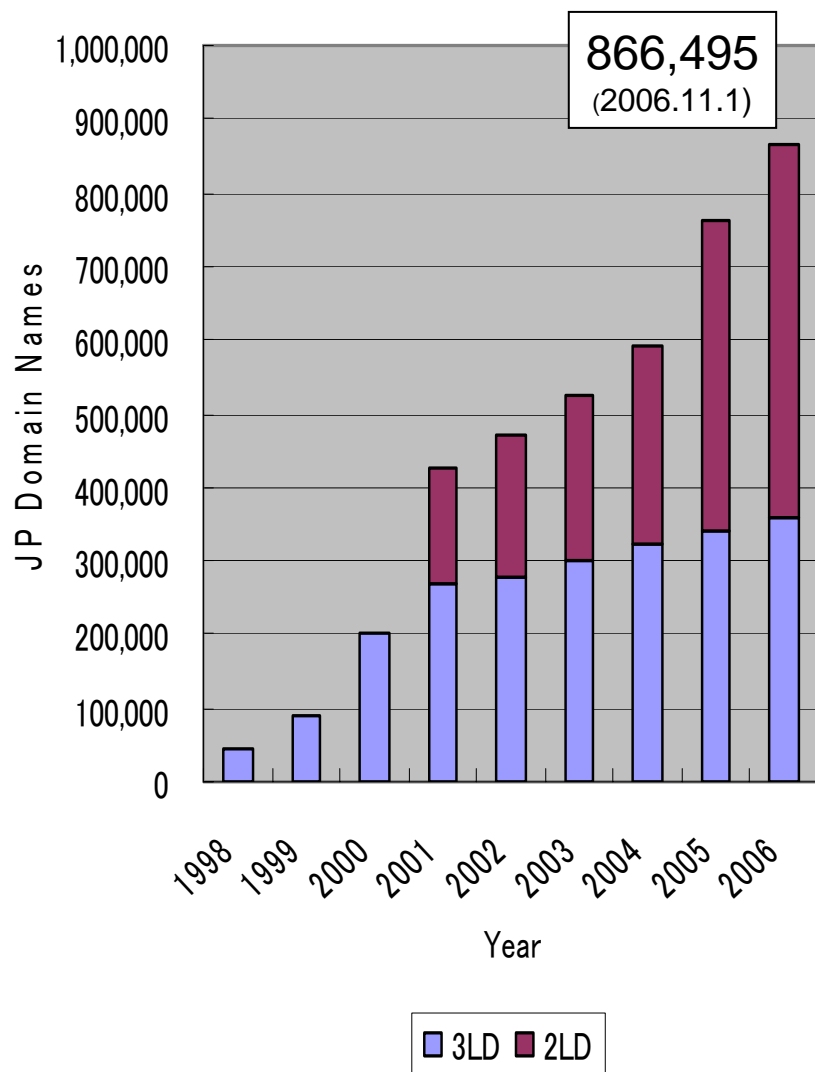
# .JP History

1986	Aug	.JP was delegated to Jun Murai
1993	Apr	JPNIC was established (Jun Murai as President)
1997	Mar	JPNIC was incorporated
2000	Oct	JP-DRP started
	Dec	JPNIC General Assembly resolved establishment of JPRS JPRS was established
2001	Feb	2 <sup>nd</sup> level .JP was launched
2002	Jan	Government endorsed JPRS as the manager for .JP top-level domain
	Feb	ICANN and JPRS signed Sponsorship Agreement
	Apr	Transfer of responsibility to JPRS was completed
